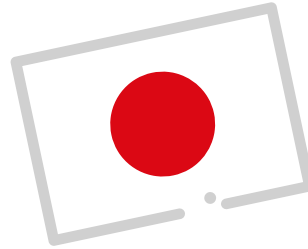


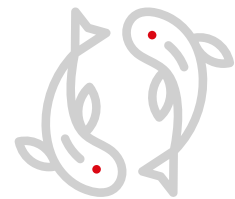
10 FACTS ABOUT JAPAN
